There are two (3) types currently offered under this announcement:

1) **Most Valuable Student Scholarships** 500 four-year scholarships, ranging from \$1,000 per year to \$15,000 per year, for graduating high school seniors based on financial need, leadership and scholarship. 2) **Legacy Awards applications**, available on-line only, are due on **February 1, 2011, at 12:00 p.m. (noon) Central Time**. 3) **Emergency Educational Grants** One-year educational grants available to children of deceased or totally disabled Elks. - The Elk parent or stepparent must have been a member in good standing for at least one year at the time of his or her death. **or**
- The Elk parent or stepparent must have been a member in good standing for at least one year before he or she became totally disabled and must continue to be an Elk in good standing when application for assistance is made.
