Boys and girls attending our Virginia Elks Youth Camp this summer will not have a problem finding the different activities! The goal was to use signs to give campers directions to the different activity areas and encourage them to use the areas. The areas requested were: archery, hiking, fishing, tubing, swimming, BB shooting, football, and soccer.

Thanks go to Charlottesville Elk member Mike Wingfield; he created the signs and brought them to life. A post with arrow shaped signs, lettered with the activity was chosen. The archery sign was designed the shape of an actual arrow with a metal tip and feathers on the end. The arrow was placed over an archery target, and placed with the point towards the archery field. The fishing sign was in the shape of a fish with a glass eye. As to the hiking and swimming signs, they each have a figure in motion hiking and swimming. The football and soccer signs have the ball of the sport attached to the sign. All signs and parts were constructed from cedar wood, painted and detailed using enamel oil base paint.
