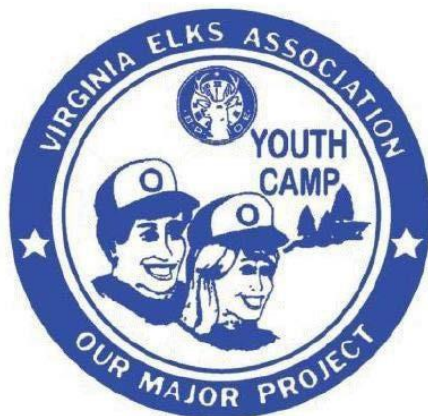


VEYC is Taking Applications for Camp Ranger

The **Virginia Elks Youth Camp, Inc.** is seeking a full time Ranger for the **Virginia Elks Youth Camp** property near Millboro, Virginia in the beautiful *George Washington National Forest*. The position will be available on October 1st, 2016 (or possibly sooner) and will be renewable annually based upon satisfactory performance of duties.

In addition to a salary, the Ranger is provided with a home on the property for himself and his family, at no personal expense. This housing benefit does not include utilities for the home (such as gas, phone, or television) but does include water and electricity. Also, the camp provides the Ranger with a pickup truck which is to be used for camp purposes. The camp pays for this vehicle, including property taxes, fuel, insurance, and vehicle upkeep and maintenance.

The Ranger is responsible for the security, maintenance, and upkeep of the physical property and grounds of the camp under the general guidance of the Executive Committee of the camp.

The Ranger will ensure that the property of the camp is maintained to the highest standards, thereby providing a safe, healthy, and beautiful facility for our campers, camp staff, visitors, and all members of the **Virginia Elks Association** to be proud of.

The Ranger will perform minor maintenance and repairs on all buildings and equipment belonging to the camp and will maintain the grounds and property in a clean and neat condition at all times.

The Ranger must demonstrate knowledge and understanding of basic carpentry, electrical, and plumbing skills. While not expected to be an expert in any of these areas, the Ranger must be a general handyman, knowing how to perform basic general repairs and maintenance and knowing when to call in a professional. He must also be capable of communicating properly with other professional maintenance personnel.

The Ranger will work with the Director of Camping during the summer camping operation, to include checking with the Director each day regarding any maintenance issues.

The **Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks** and the **Virginia Elks Youth Camp** strongly support our nation's youth and veterans. Veterans and Wounded Warriors will be given first preference.
